

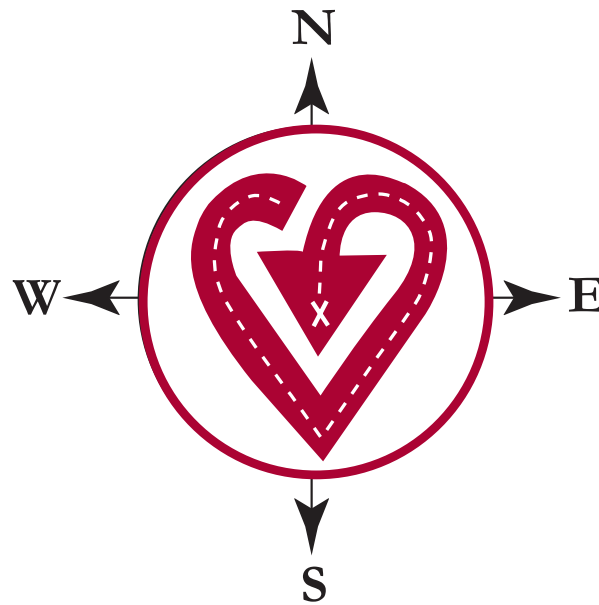

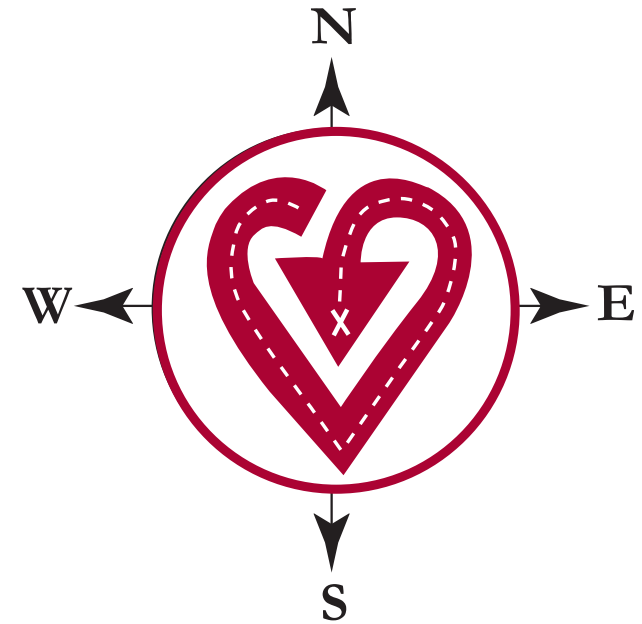

# Purpose

**V**olunteer Transportation Service is a program for people who are ambulatory and have difficulty using public transit because of age or a disability.

The program helps Kenosha County seniors and persons with disabilities attend local and regional medical appointments. Shopping for groceries, prescriptions, banking and other personal business are also made possible by our volunteer program.

Our goal is to help elderly and disabled persons to stay in their own homes and to support families who care for them. We provide safe and dependable transportation.



# Reservations

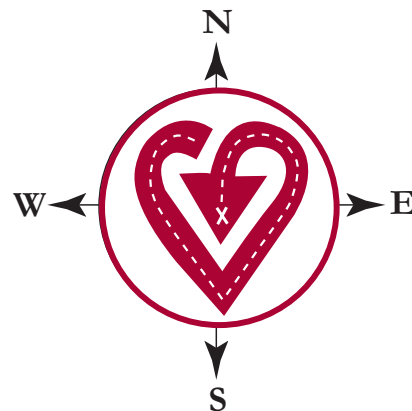
To request a ride call (262) 842-7433

- ◆ Monday through Friday
- ◆ 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- ◆ A 2 - 3 day notice should be given; however, more notice is encouraged.

Rides are based on the availability of drivers. Special requests for weekend or evening hours can be made.

Drivers use their own vehicles for all trips, therefore, do not have wheelchair lifts. We are able to provide service to persons using assistive devices such as canes, walkers and/or portable oxygen.

If the rider requires an attendant, the attendant must stay with the rider for the full trip. The attendant *will not* be charged a fare.



# Fares

EFFECTIVE: JANUARY 1, 2012

**Trips less than 10 miles, one-way**

- ◆ \$4.50 one-way
- ◆ Additional local stops can be made at the rate of \$1.00 per stop, with notice given at the time of the reservation.

**Trips 10 miles or more, one-way**

- ◆ First 25 miles will be calculated at 75 cents per mile, one-way.
- ◆ If applicable, after 25 miles, each mile will be calculated @ 50 cents per mile, one-way.

**Payment is due at the time of your trip.** If you need to cancel or make changes to your original request, contact the office directly as soon as possible. (262) 842-7433

**Rate Assistance**

- ◆ Written applications for reduced fare are available to low income and asset riders.
- ◆ Fares help pay for the drivers' mileage reimbursement.
