LONG-TERM CARE MEDICAID WAIVER PROGRAMS

Medicaid Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Waiver Programs help people who are elderly, blind, or disabled remain living in their own homes or in community settings rather than in nursing homes or state medical facilities.

Your county's Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) serves as an unbiased access point for these **person-centered** care programs. To be eligible, individuals must meet Medicaid income and asset requirements and demonstrate a qualifying functional level of care (either nursing-home or non-nursing-home level).

These programs approve services designed to address individual needs and barriers, helping participants reach their goals and live as independently as possible in the community.

Family Care Program

Team • Participant. • A care manager. • A registered nurse. • A family member or loved one (optional). • Other professionals.

The Family Care Program provides additional long-term care supports while participants continue to choose their own doctors. The program focuses on helping participants remain independent and safe in their homes or communities.

Family Care Partnership Program

Team • Participant. • A doctor. • A nurse practitioner. • A care manager. • A registered nurse. • A family member or loved one (optional). • Other professionals.

The Family Care Partnership Program offers a full range of **long-term, primary, acute and preventive care** through an interdisciplinary care team. This program is designed for participants with complex health needs and offers continuous, coordinated care that adapts as needs change. Participants must receive all routine care from providers within the program's healthcare network.

IRIS (Include, Respect, I Self-Direct) Program

IRIS allows participants or their guardians to **choose, control, and design** their approved support and service plans to meet functional, vocational, medical, and social needs. Participants are responsible for arranging the care they receive at home or in the community. IRIS is grounded in the core values of **self-determination**, independence, and personal choice.

PACE (Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly) 55+ years

Team • Participant. • A PACE or community doctor. • A registered nurse. • A care manager. • A PACE center coordinator. • A home care coordinator. • Physical, occupational, and recreational therapists. • A dietitian. • A family member or loved one (optional). • Other professionals.

PACE is an innovative program that provides a comprehensive range of long-term care, medical services, and prescription drugs. The goal is to help participants live as independently as possible while receiving coordinated, all-inclusive care.
